What does the ETCC Technical Committee do?

The ETCC is an advisory committee to discuss technical issues before and during the ETCC and to review EU regulations in regards to how they apply to the ETCC and if necessary to put forward suggestions for supplementary rules in addition to the ITCC rules.

The committee shall debate new techniques and tools and whether they are to be allowed to be used in the ETCC. Further the committee will communicate these decisions ahead of the ETCC via the event web-site.

How to bring new techniques and equipment to the ETCC?

If you are considering bringing new equipment to the competition be sure to bring along documentation on technical specifications. If you are unable to provide any details (manufacturer, breaking strain, materials etc.) the equipment may not pass gear check. For example new ideas or novel configurations should be accompanied with test data. If you have any doubts as to the correct procedure you can get in touch via the ETCC web-site.
